

Horizons at Episcopal Academy Board of Directors 2023-2024 Committees

Overview

Much of the work of the Horizons at Episcopal Academy (HEA) Board is completed by various Board Committees. Committees are comprised of Board Members/Observers and other HEA volunteers/employees with the exception of the Governance and Finance Committees, which are comprised of Board Members/Observers only.

Meeting Frequency

Each committee typically meets quarterly beginning in the Fall (September) of each year and holds its final quarterly meeting prior to the start of the Summer program (June). When needed, committees may choose to hold additional meetings to accomplish initiatives/tasks. The meetings are typically held in person; however, virtual options are available to accommodate committee members.

Committee Leadership

Each committee is led by a Committee Chair. In some instances, a committee will be led by Co-Chairs. Customarily, there is a renewable two-year term for Committee leadership positions. However, if a majority of the Board Members on the Committee agrees, the term can be extended.

Committee Organization

Each Committee is responsible for keeping its own notes at Committee meetings and typing up Minutes from these notes. Chairs may assign this task to other member(s) of their committee. Once prepared, the Minutes should be distributed via email to Committee members. The Executive Director should be copied if not a committee member and will keep a record of all committee Meeting Minutes.
