What is Horizons Heroes?

Horizons Heroes is a giving community designed for donors who want to make a significant commitment to support the transformation journey of our Horizons at EA students. Participating donors assist in funding the Horizons student's experience at an annual giving level for 3 years. The minimum annual commitment is \$2,500, the average per student cost of our signature six-week summer learning program.
